Merseyside FBU members are asked to report to the relevant authority, formally if necessary, these daily occurrences and the frequency of these events need to be reported to the relevant authorities to keep a balanced view. Please bring this All Members circular to the attention of all FBU members in Merseyside.

All FBU members are also reminded to stay in contact with their branch officials, all of whom are picketing their places of work. The picket lines will have officials with the latest information and be able to give advice and guidance regarding all aspects our current dispute.
